

**SIDELETTER BY AND BETWEEN
THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE
SAN DIEGO EDUCATION ASSOCIATION
January 9, 2006**

This Sideletter is entered into by and between the San Diego Unified School District ("the District") and the San Diego Education Association ("SDEA").

Pursuant to the December 6, 2005 tentative agreement, the parties agree that the 2005/2006 work year calendar will be configured as follows:

2005/2006 Single Track Year-Round

- February 10, 2006 will become a K-12 teacher non-workday.

2005/2006 Traditional

- June 22, 2006 will become a K-12 teacher non-workday.

The parties also agree to the following changes to the configuration of the 2006/2007 work year calendar to be presented to the Board of Education for approval:


2006/2007 Single Track Year Round

- August 31, September 1, and February 9, 2006 will no longer be designated as staff development days.
 - February 9, 2007 will become a teacher workday with students in attendance.
 - March 30, 2007 will become a non-teacher workday and a non-student day.
- It is understood that year round site principals and certificated staffs will continue to jointly agree to the placement of the four (4) teacher preparation days at their individual school.
 - The first day teachers report to work will be determined by the placement of the four (4) preparation days. Two examples of possible preparation day placement: 1) August 30-31, September 1, and July 21; or August 31, September 1, April 24, and July 21.


2006-2007 Traditional

- August 28 and 29, 2006 will become teacher non-workdays.
- August 30, 31 and September 1, 2006 will become teacher preparation days.
- February 9, 2007 will become a teacher workday with students in attendance.
- June 20, 2007 will become a teacher preparation day with no students in attendance.
- June 21, 2007 will become a teacher non-workday.
