**Subject: Meeting for the New Memorial Area Middle School**

San Diego City Schools invites you to a community meeting to help determine the location of a new middle school in the Mountain View/Southcrest area. The new middle school will not replace Memorial Academy, but will instead help alleviate overcrowding at Memorial. The need for a new middle school in this area was approved by the Board of Education at its regular board meeting on August 5, 2003. The overall area being considered for the new school is shown on the attached map.

The community meeting is scheduled as follows:

Date: Thursday – February 26, 2004

Time: 6:30 p.m.

Location: Memorial Academy (auditorium), 2850 Logan Avenue

At the meeting, you will hear from school district representatives about potential locations for the new middle school, the need for the new middle school and other requirements affecting new school site selection.

Proposition MM funds will help build the new school. On November 3, 1998, Proposition MM was passed by 78 percent of San Diego voters. Proposition MM provides \$1.51 billion toward the \$4 billion of needed repairs and upgrades at our neighborhood schools, as well as construction of 13 new schools to serve students throughout the San Diego City Schools.
