Subject: Follow-up Meeting for the New Memorial Area Middle School

San Diego City Schools invites you to a follow-up community meeting to help determine the location of a new middle school in the Mountain View/Southcrest area. Additional information has been obtained which will require modifying the previously identified site locations. A presentation will be made on this additional information and potential site locations will be reviewed at a community meeting on June 9.

The need for a new middle school in this area was approved by the Board of Education on August 5, 2003. The new middle school will not replace Memorial Academy, but will instead help alleviate overcrowding at Memorial. The overall area being considered for the new school and the current potential site locations are shown on the attached map.

The community meeting is scheduled as follows:

Date: Wednesday – June 9, 2004

Time: 6:30 p.m.

Location: Memorial Academy (auditorium), 2850 Logan Avenue

Proposition MM funds will help build the new school. In 1998, Proposition MM was passed by 78 percent of San Diego voters to provide \$1.51 billion toward the \$4 billion of needed repairs and upgrades at our neighborhood schools, as well as construction of 13 new schools to serve students throughout the San Diego City Schools.
