Subject: Community Meeting for the Proposed Memorial Area Middle School

San Diego City Schools invites you to a community meeting to receive an update regarding the site selection process for the proposed new Memorial Area Middle School. After four meetings with the community and area planning groups, three sites have been identified for further evaluation under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Environmental Impact Report (EIR) process. The three sites are identified on the attached map (Attachment 1).

At the meeting, you will hear what the next steps are in the school site evaluation process, including CEQA requirements, environmental site assessment criteria, property acquisition, and relocation activities.

Location: Memorial Academy, 2850 Logan Avenue

Proposition MM funds will help build the new school. In 1998, Proposition MM was passed by 78 percent of San Diego voters to provide \$1.51 billion toward the \$4 billion of needed repairs and upgrades at our neighborhood schools, as well as construction of new/rebuilt schools to serve students throughout the San Diego City Schools.
